DRUGDEV

Requirement

Growing computer software company, DrugDev, which provides cloud-based solutions to help sponsors, CROs and investigators do more clinical trials, retained NAI Hunneman to find office space to support the company’s continued expansion.

First and foremost, DrugDev wanted to maintain their company culture in addition to recruiting and retaining talented employees. In the search for the perfect space, DrugDev required NAI Hunneman to look at both the suburbs and downtown Boston.

Approach

NAI Hunneman applied a multi-faceted approach by utilizing the depth of the firm. Evan Gallagher, Principal of the Life Sciences team along with Matthew Davis of the firm’s Downtown team worked in tandem on an exhaustive search for spaces that best preserved DrugDev’s company culture. The requirements lead the Leasing and Advisory Services team to search exclusively in the Seaport and Financial District, and the Suburban team to search in the Newton area.

Results

After careful consideration of available spaces, DrugDev made the decision to move into downtown Boston’s ever-expanding Seaport district. NAI Hunneman then narrowed the focus exclusively to brick and beam spaces in the area, finding that 25 Thomson Place was the perfect fit for the growing company. The close proximity to transportation & amenities aligned perfectly with DrugDev and its employees.
